
 Are you ready? Start the recording and while it's playing, colour in and decorate your colouring picture. Be quick (you have exactly 1:42 minutes!) because as soon as the song is over, you'll have to stop colouring.



- 2) You choose After finishing, ...
 - present your picture to the group. Describe it in detail and say why you made it this way. Finally vote for the nicest/funniest, etc. drawing.

OR


make sure the others cannot see your coloured-in picture. Find a partner who has <u>not</u> chosen <u>the same picture</u> as you. Ask your partner to turn round (so he/she cannot see you) and describe <u>your</u> picture, e.g. "There is a golden angel on top of the tree ...", etc. Your partner has to draw whatever you tell him/her. When you are finished, compare your pictures. Same or different? (Your partner's picture does not look like yours? Perhaps your descriptions were not clear or exact enough? Don't worry - it's a fun activity!)
